

## **Medication Instruction**

## CONFIRM THAT AN ADEQUATE AMOUNT OF MEDICATION is packed for the entire camp session.

Our nurses will dispense medications beginning with Sunday supper and ending with Saturday breakfast. Please be sure that all medications due before Sunday supper on arrival day have been given before you leave. At the end of the session, any remaining medications will be returned.

We will only accept medications that are labeled with the camper's name and the medication name.

All oral medications (except liquids or powders) need to be "unit dosed" before coming to camp. Please see the examples below for the correct way to label the individual unit dosed packets. Small, clear medication bags or Ziploc bags work the best. It is CRUCIAL that the camper's name, medication name and day/time medication is to be given (breakfast, lunch, afternoon, supper, bed time) are on the label. Please bring original prescription bottles so the nurse can verify medications. FYI - Some pharmacies will unit dose the medications for you at no charge.

\*\*Using mailing labels or paper and tape, print or write the required information and then adhere the label to the bag. All medication for one-time period can be put in the same labeled baggie.
