To maintain and reduce the possibility of development negatively impacting the quality and beauty of these viewsheds, organizations including the Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation, through initiatives such as Blue Ridge Rising, have partnered with the National Park Service, local communities, and other community organizations to establish a baseline assessment for all the viewsheds at major overlooks. The Park Break program will undertake this effort by conducting baseline qualitative assessments for each viewpoint between milepost 202 and milepost 317.5.
