

Graduate Admissions Requirements for Electrical Engineering applies to students without a B.S. Degree in Electrical Engineering from an ABET-accredited program.

Basic Science: at least one course in a basic science, preferably chemistry (Ch 101).

Physics: at least two courses in calculus-based physics including at least one laboratory (PHYS 122, 221, 223).

Mathematics: the equivalent of the Clemson calculus sequence (MthSC 106, 108, and 206), ordinary differential equations (MthSC 208), and theory of probability (ECE 317 or MthSC 400).
Equivalent of ECE courses through junior year.
