I, _____, plan to participate in the following PROGRAM at Clemson University (UNIVERSITY): **The 2022 Online EUREKA! Summer Honors Research Program**

This PROGRAM is designed for incoming first-year students accepted into the Clemson University Honors College. Students will work virtually with research mentors on projects. It gives participants the opportunity to learn laboratory research skills as well as meet faculty and other Honors students in a more relaxed setting prior to the beginning of the fall 2022 academic semester.

The PROGRAM is sponsored/organized by the Clemson University Honors College and will take place virtually on the following date(s): June 20, 2022 through July 22, 2022. The itinerary for the 2022 Online EUREKA! Summer Honors Research Program is attached and incorporated herein by this reference. The PROGRAM fee pays for a portion of the cost of the summer program which is supplemented by the Honors College. The itinerary describes many ACTIVITIES planned for the PROGRAM participants including but not limited to ACTIVITIES described in paragraph 1 below.

In consideration for being allowed to participate in this PROGRAM, I the undersigned, acknowledge, appreciate and agree that:

1. 2022 Online EUREKA! affords me the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of ACTIVITIES, including but not limited to online meetings and learning sessions, online discussions with faculty and other students, at home research projects which may involve the use of lab equipment and materials, online exercise classes, cooking activities, etc. There are inherent risks involved with these ACTIVITIES, including but not limited to burns, fires, eye injuries, injuries from chemicals, bumps, scrapes, bruises, broken bones, head injuries, drowning, vehicle accidents, injuries from physical exercise, lost or stolen person property, data mining, phishing, viruses, malware, data breach of online information, cyberbullying, allegations of infringement and image replication, cyber stalking, etc., and I choose to voluntarily participate in these ACTIVITIES and accept full responsibility for any risk of loss, property damage or personal injury, including death, which may be sustained by me as a result of my participation.
2. While participating in any online meeting or lesson I understand and agree that I must be appropriately dressed and conduct myself properly, including refraining from driving during PROGRAM virtual events. Any inappropriate dress, distracted behavior, or disruptive behavior that interferes with the PROGRAM will not be tolerated. Any repeated instance of inappropriate dress, distracted behavior, or disruptive behavior could result in dismissal from the PROGRAM depending on the circumstances. Such decisions will be made by the Executive Director of the Honors College or his designee. In most cases, a third occurrence will result in a dismissal from the PROGRAM.
3. In addition to item 2 above, I also understand and agree that the Clemson University Student Code of Conduct applies to me while participating in the PROGRAM. I understand that a violation of the Student Code of Conduct could result in my dismissal from the PROGRAM and/or the Clemson University, depending on the severity of the violation.

On behalf of myself and my heirs, I hereby release, waive, and discharge Clemson University and its Board of Trustees, its officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, demands, liabilities, rights and causes of action of whatever kind or nature, that may result from or occur during my participation in the PROGRAM, whether caused by negligence of the UNIVERSITY, its Board of Trustees, officers, agents, employees or representatives or otherwise. I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless the UNIVERSITY for any loss, liability, damage or costs, including court costs and attorney's fees that may occur as a result of my negligent or intentional act or omission while participating in these ACTIVITIES or the PROGRAM.
