TIGER TRANSIT

Tiger Transit is operated under the direction of the Division of Student Affairs by the Student Patrol, a student organization affiliated with the Clemson

University Police Department. Tiger Transit serves all Clemson University students, faculty, staff and visitors.

For your safety and convenience, Tiger Transit drivers are pleased to provide door-to-door service from any location on Clemson's campus.

Hours of Operation

Tiger Transit operates seven days a week from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. During peak traffic times surrounding home football games, this service may not be available. Tiger Transit does not operate when Clemson University is not in session.

How to Request a Ride

Call 864-656-3333 or access clemson.edu/tiger-transit via desktop, laptop, tablet, smartphone or any internet-enabled device and enter a ride request. If using an Android device, get the free Tiger Transit app from the Google Play store. If using an iOS device, the free app is available in Apple's App Store as well.

Tiger Transit is now a part of the my.Clemson app. Now, anyone with an internet-enabled device can easily access the ride request screen and get a ride with Tiger Transit. From the my.Clemson app, select the transit tab and choose Tiger Transit Request. Real-time bus tracking for all routes is available through the my.Clemson app. Learn more at clemson.edu/mobile.

The CUPD acts as the University's central site for lost items. To report a lost or found item, call 864-656-0433 or visit the police station between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

PROPERTY REGISTRATION

Students may register their property with the CUPD online at clemson.edu/cupd/services.html. This service allows students to register the serial numbers of their valuables for easy access in the event any of these items are lost or stolen.

CRIME PREVENTION

Despite the relatively low level of crimes that occur on campus and in the surrounding city, illegal activity is still a real possibility. CU SAFE ALERTS

CU Safe Alerts will inform you of campus emergencies or disruptions to campus services. Most CU Safe Alerts are sent as text messages to your mobile phone and to all @clemson.edu email addresses.

Students and employees are automatically registered to receive text alerts when they verify their address and emergency contact information at the beginning of the semester or calendar year. To be sure you are registered or to sign up to receive CU Safe Alerts on your mobile phone, go to getrave.com/login/clemson.

RAVE GUARDIAN

The Rave Guardian app is available to help keep you safe on campus. With direct connections to campus safety, family, friends and others you trust, you can feel safe anytime, knowing your guardians are watching out for you. RAVE Guardian also can send an anonymous text directly to CUPD. If you need to report suspicious activity or a crime in progress, you can use this feature through RAVE Guardian.
