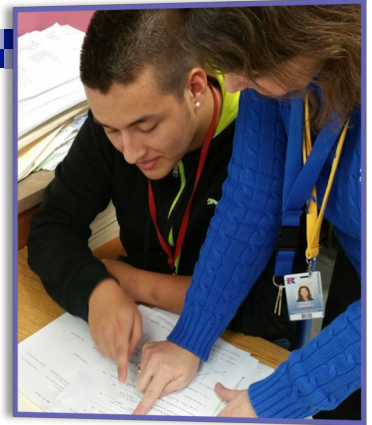

Middle and High School teachers can receive a graduate degree designed to improve disciplinary literacy teaching and prepare you for instructional leadership. The Clemson MEd-Literacy Secondary Strand is entirely online, taught on a 7-week schedule, in an interactive setting through specially designed coursework they can access as their schedules permit.

### Are you interested in becoming a secondary literacy leader?

<b>Degree Requirements:</b>	36 semester hours (for any strand). Additional requirements include requisite years of teaching experience, PRAXIS exam, and other requirements as indicated by the SC Department of Education.
<b>Course Format:</b>	Our courses are offered 100% online. (However, a district may contract with us to provide blended or face-to-face courses.)
<b>Length of Program:</b>	Our Secondary Strand students take two 7-week courses during fall and spring and complete the degree in 2-2.5 years. <b>Application deadline is June 15, 2020 and the program begins in the fall semester each year.</b>

<b>Investment:</b>	Investing in a graduate degree has professional and economic benefits. The tuition cost of the M.Ed. is substantially offset by future earnings. For example, in most districts, a teacher with one year of teaching experience will receive a pay increase of \$5,000 or more upon completion of the M.Ed., so total cost of the M.Ed. degree is recovered in 2-3 years or less.
