Clemson University students, including many from the College of Education and Call Me MISTER, spent the MLK holiday volunteering at local service organizations.

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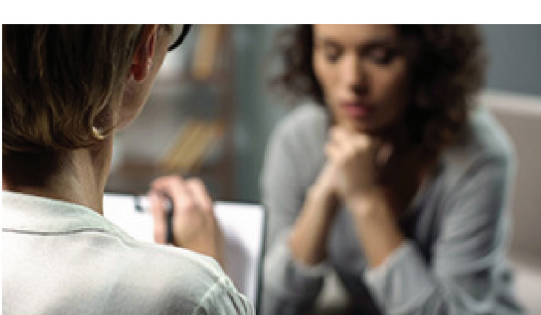

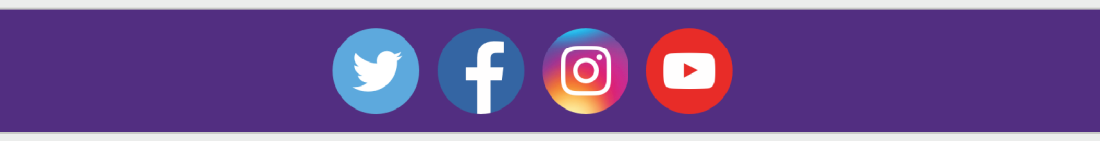


COE Spotlight
