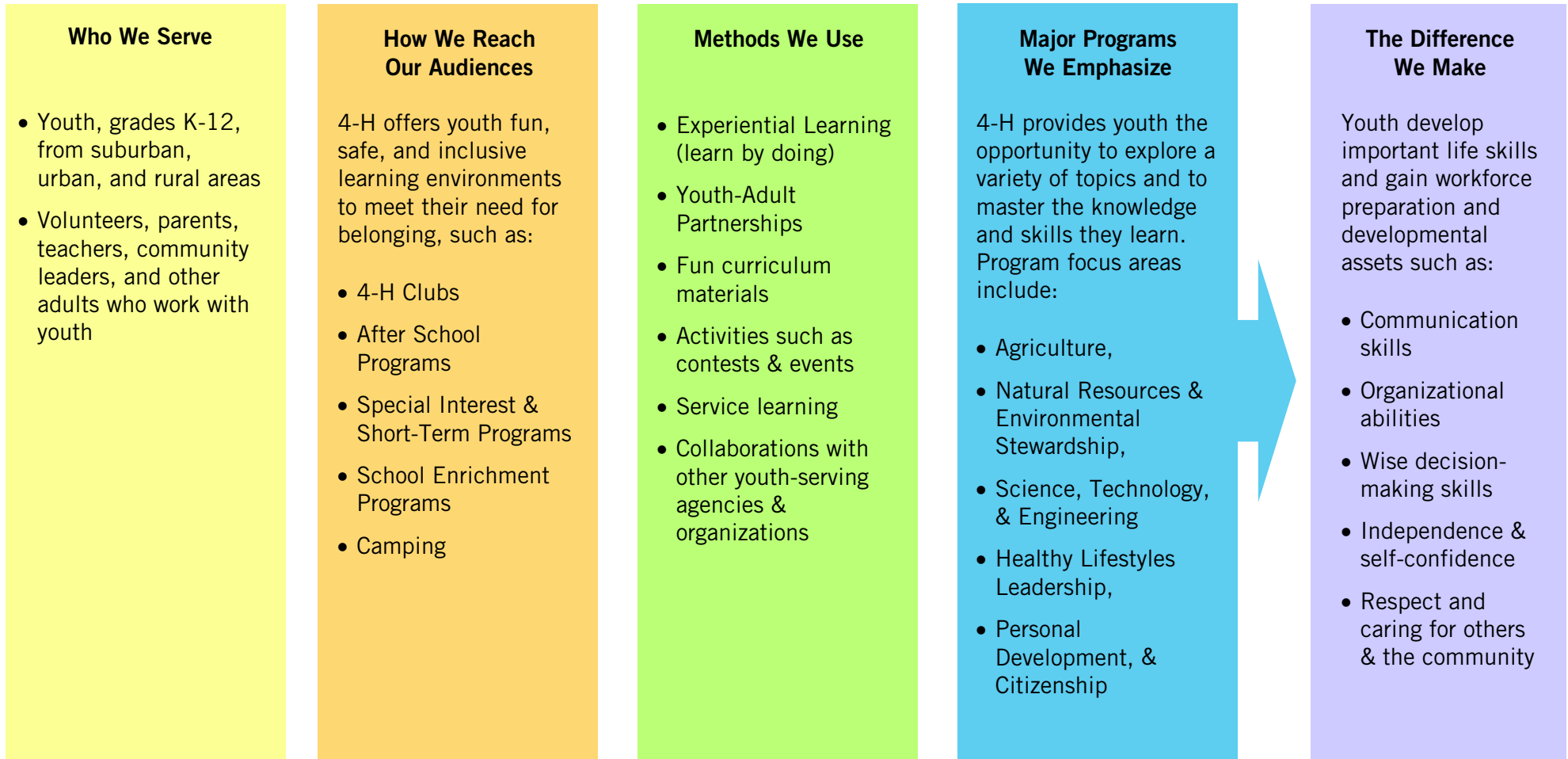


4-H Youth Development: Investing in South Carolina's Future
