<p>Early leaf Spot (Cercospora arachidicola)</p> <p>Late leaf spot (Cercosporidium personatum)</p>	<p>2.5</p> <p>0.037 lb. ai/A</p>	<p>Begin applications prior to onset of disease when conditions are favorable for disease development, generally around 30 to 40 days after planting.</p> <p>Reapply DOMARK 230 ME using a 14 day interval.</p> <p>DOMARK 230 ME may be used in State Agricultural Extension advisory (disease forecasting) programs which specify application timing based on environmental factors favorable for disease development.</p> <p>Sufficient water volume must be used to ensure thorough coverage for best disease control. Ground application is recommended for best results.</p> <p>Application may be made by ground, air, or chemigation. Apply in 0.1 to 0.25 inches/A of water for chemigation applications. Chemigation application using excessive water could lead to reduced efficacy.</p>
