



MEAT GOAT SHOW

Monday, September 5, 2022

Check-in: 2:00 pm

Judging: 3:00 pm

(or 30 minutes after Beef & Dairy Heifer Shows)

Rules and Regulations:

1. The Meat Goat Show starts at 3:00 pm (or 30 minutes after the Beef and Dairy Heifer Shows) on Monday, September 5, 2022. **All goats will be weighed-in from 2:00 – 2:30 pm on the day of the show (or beginning immediately after completion of the Beef and Dairy Heifer Shows). Scales will be closed promptly at 2:30 pm. Any goats not weighed-in will not be permitted to show.**
2. Showmanship ages are determined as of January 1, 2022. Exhibitors may show any goat in Showmanship that they have entered in Open Wethers or Market Doe classes. Goats must be shown by his/her owner. Exceptions include the Toddler and Adult Showmanship classes. Novice exhibitors may request an older youth exhibitor registered at this show to assist them in the show ring, but the assistant cannot set up or brace the goat.
3. Open Wethers: Open wethers are allowed. There will be 3 classes of Open Market Wethers, as determined by the wether's weight the day of the show.
4. Market Does: Market Does must be born between September 1, 2021 and June 10, 2022. There will be 3 classes of Market Does, as determined by the doe's weight the day of the show. Each exhibitor may weigh in up to 6 does. Exhibitors may show more than 1 doe per weight class, but additional goats may only be shown by youth exhibitors registered at this show.
5. Exhibitors must furnish feed and water pails for their animals.
6. Facilities are available to wash your animal, however no electricity is available.
