

Newberry Eagles Shotgun Team Rules

- Practice and use good firearm safety at all times.
- Wear eye and ear protection at all times during practices & event.
- Absolutely no playing with or around firearms of any type.
- Absolutely no foul language or any form of disrespect will be tolerated. If this rule is disobeyed, you and your team member will be asked to leave the premises of an event or practice.
- All team members are required to maintain a "11 C or better average" in school.
- No parent will be allowed to coach their child or another team member during practice or a meet unless they have taken the proper coaching.
- certification classes. We enforce this rule at practice to ensure safety for all involved. If a parent disobeys this rule during an event it will cause the team and/or squad to be disqualified during an event.
- No child is allowed to drive his or herself to an event. If this rule is disobeyed the consequences of an accident will result in non-coverage by team insurance for the entire team.
- Parents or legal guardian must attend events with their team member. If event requires overnight stay the parents or guardian will need to make arrangements for their team member. Coaches are not required to be responsible or allow team members to stay with them on overnight visits.
- Any team member under the age of 12 must have a parent or legal guardian present during the entire practice or event.
- No one under the age of 16 without a legal South Carolina Driver's License will be allowed to operate golf carts, Sports UTVs, or Four Wheelers at events or practices. If you disobey this rule it will result in team disqualification at an event. If you do this at practice you will be asked to vacate the premises.
- There will be no skipping practices. We do have several options for practice so there is no reason to not practice on a regular basis. Anyone who consistently misses practice will lose their squad position to the next available team member who practices on a regular basis and qualifies.
- Squadding is determined by scores and category as determined by the Head & Assistant Coaches. Everyone will know how they are squadded and their coach well before scheduled events. The squads will be determined by the Head & Assistant Coaches before each event. Once the squads are set they may not be changed by anyone for that event. In the event a parent has questions about this matter they will need to address only the head coach at the appropriate time and place away from team members & parents.
- Coaches must work together to help maintain good team morale and report any concerns or questions to the Head Coach.
- Parents we always need volunteers and you are our best support system. Please get involved with the team when asked to volunteer.
- Everyone involved is encouraged to give positive feedback to team members to ensure that they keep a positive attitude and maintain good sportsmanship.
- Remember without rules we cannot function in unison and allow our team members to "Make the Best Better."
