Combined Bachelor's & Master's degree plan

How does a combined plan work?

- You reduce the time needed to earn both degrees by applying graduate credits to both bachelor's and master's program requirements
- You pay no additional graduate school application fee
- You don't have to take the GRE
- You may apply up to 12 credit hours of graduate courses to your bachelor's program requirements

How can I find out if I'm eligible?

To qualify for the Combined Bachelor's/Master's Plan, you must have completed your bachelor's curriculum through your junior year (at least 90 credits) with a minimum overall grade point ratio of 3.4.
