We re-opened the 18th hole this past month, and we hope you are enjoying the new finishing hole. We would love to hear your comments! Currently, we are in the process of updating our scorecards with new yardages and ratings. The South Carolina Golf Association has already updated the USGA-GHIN ratings, so your score posting should be accurate.

If you subscribe to GPS phone application services, you will want to contact them directly to have them update their satellite images and distances for the new 18th hole.

Once we have all the stones on site for the work around the fountain pond project, we will return to playing hole 18 as a temporary par three until that work is finished. We anticipate that occurring between December and March. Enjoy it while the weather is good.

October Status

October was on the dry side, which is typical. We finished the drainage work on the #1 fairway and opened the new 18th hole. We made our second fungicide application to the fairways for spring dead spot control and reseeded some weak spots in the newly seeded natural areas on #6 and #7/8.

On October 16th, we overseeded the tees on holes #8 and #17 and the practice tees. This was a week later than planned, and the seed took a little longer to sprout. We have a good stand, and we made the first cut on the 30th. Even though we are restricted to the mats, we overseed the main practice tees in the hopes that we could move back onto them at some point.

We prepped and sodded the slope on the front of the #1 tee the week of the 23rd. This area had become very weedy, so we decided it was time to start over.

Rock continues to trickle in for the pond project on #18 slowly. We are still on track to do this work in December and January once we receive all the rocks on site.

November Goals

November brings cooler temps and the peak leaf drop. We will be busy blowing leaves and transitioning away from routine mowing as the grass shuts down and into more winter project type work. This work includes under brushing, dead tree removal, adding sand and repairing liner where needed in the bunkers and a few drainage improvements we hope to make. In addition, we have started making our course-wide winter herbicide application to keep the course clean and weed free through the spring.

The mats will be utilized on the tees on #4 and #12 again this winter and placed out the week of November 6^{th} . I feel another year of not overseeding these tees will allow the bermudagrass to continue to improve and get stronger.

Also, the guardrail on #5 will be extended the full length of the hole and the gate at our access point will be reinstalled. We will also work in these specific locations to dress up the areas disturbed by the Perimeter Road project.

Bridge Replacement December 11-15

Just a reminder, the front nine will be closed the week of December 11-15 to allow for the replacement of the wooden cart bridge on #1. This bridge is 28 years old, and other than replacing some of the decking boards, no work has been done on this critical piece of infrastructure. We plan to strip it down to the pilings and build it back with all new lumber. I know this is an inconvenience, but it is something that must be done. Please mark your calendars accordingly.
