#### Hole # 18 Rock Project

With the arrival of more rock, the fountain pond project is back underway. The contractor will be working to complete the project as quickly as possible. We anticipate a four or five-week completion timeframe. Based on which side of the pond the crew is working, a determination of how we can play the hole will be made daily. We will have to utilize the fairway temporary green and play it as a par three when there is crew safe-

ty concerns. When the crew is not working, we will play the hole as a regular par four to the new green. Please check with the golf shop daily before going out to know how number 18 will be playing that day. Your understanding and cooperation is greatly appreciated.

#### **DAC Project Updates**

As you have probably already experienced, parking continues to be a challenge. We are now approaching the busy season for the conference center, hotel and golf course! The extra business will put even more pressure on available parking. Please be patient as you search for parking. Carpooling (when possible) will be a good idea. Additional shuttle vehicles are on the way and we are increasing our staff presence in the parking lots to help shuttle you to the golf shop from your parking space.

The temporary golf shop trailer is scheduled to arrive this month and will take a couple of weeks to be ready for occupancy. Once the new cart barn and temporary golf shop are ready we will move our operations into the trailer. When that occurs the current parking lot will be closed down and the current golf shop will be demolished. All golf parking will be directed to the new parking lot located near the temporary golf shop at the end of the practice range.

A "food truck" will be placed near the practice range tee to serve as the food and beverage center for golfers before, during, and after your golf round. Solé On The Green staff will operate the food truck. Stay tuned for more information as it is made available in the next month.

#### March Status

March brought continued rain keeping the course on the wet side. We have recorded over 21 inches of rain in the first 3 months of the year. Things have been slowly warming up with no late deep freezing, so the bermudagrass is waking up like it should with shady and north facing slopes lagging.

On March 4<sup>th</sup>, we were able to make our course wide application of slow release fertilizer and summer pre-emergent weed control. The temperatures were optimum for crabgrass germination so it was important to get it down when we did. It was a little on the wet side, but we were able to get the bulk spreader truck on the course without leaving too many tracks. Number 1 and lower 9 were a little too wet so we waited and applied the weed control ourselves on the 15<sup>th</sup>.

#### Winter Projects

Even with all the rain we had a very productive winter from a project standpoint. In addition to the major work I listed last month we were able to do several tree removals, under brushing, repaired several drains, replenished the sand in the bunkers on 8 and make some irrigation improvements all with our in-house staff.

#### April Goals

April sees us return to more routine mowing and maintenance and less project work as the grass greens up and begins to grow.

We will perform a solid tine aeration of the greens mid-month with <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inch tines to improve water infiltration and gas exchange. There will be little, if any impact on ball roll especially after rolling the greens a couple of times.

The mats on holes 4 & 12 will be removed around mid-month. We need some warmer weather to get the grass growing so that we will see recovery from divots. Unfortunately there are a lot of divots on some of these tees now from players who did not follow the rules. Thanks to all of you who did co-operate by using the mats this winter.

Mulching beds will be another priority for April.

## 18<sup>th</sup> Hole Pond Update

Work is restarting this month on the pond project on 18. How this hole plays on a day-to-day basis and will change depending on the work that is occurring. If the men are working we will play it as a par 3. When it does play as a par 3 we will try to play it from the fairway to the regulation green. However, there may be some days we have to use the temporary green. On the weekends and on other days the contractor is not working we will play the hole as a par 4. Thanks for your understanding as we finish up this project.
