Winter Update

While December was more normal weather-wise, January has been crazy. The 4.5 inches of rain that fell in 12 hours on Tuesday, January 9th, caused the creek to flood and spread some debris and silt on holes 1, 2 and 9. Things were much better with the new retention ponds along Perimeter Road. I have noticed other issues related to the surrounding watershed that might be causing some problems and have contacted the City's stormwater engineer to look at these issues.

The following week, we were hit with a cold snap that required us to cover the greens for several days to protect them from winter injury. We recorded a low of 13.3 degrees at our weather station.

Once the covers came off on the 22nd, we were hit with another week of rain, bringing our monthly total to over 8 inches. The good news about all the rain is that the lake is almost full, and the Corps website projects it to be at full pool by early March!

Project Update

The wooden cart bridge at 1 tee was rebuilt as scheduled the week of December 11th. The bridge and concrete approaches look very nice. It feels good to have this important piece of infrastructure rebuilt.

While the bridge work occurred, we used the closed front nine for some much-needed tree work on holes 1, 2, and 5.

The directional signs were removed on January 8th to be refurbished. After ten years, they needed new paint and lettering. The posts have been painted, and the panels should be reinstalled before the end of the month.

During February, we will be underbrush along the 15th and 16th holes in the wooded areas bordering the lake, allowing for a better water view. We met with the Army Corps to clearly understand what we can and cannot do. As this land is leased to the golf course, we have more flexibility than a homeowner bordering the lake.

On February 5th and 6th, we will remove the large tree behind #11 green next to the cart path. This large double leader oak is in bad shape. From the path, it looks fine, but step around to the backside, and you can see a large cavity rotted out of the trunk. We have tried to hang onto it for years, even adding a cable for stability, but it is too much of a liability. On the 6th, the back nine will be closed, and you will play the front 9 twice.

#18 Pond Update

Due to more supply chain issues and a desire to get a better-quality rock, work on 18 pond has been paused, and we have resumed playing 18 as a par 4. We will continue to play 18 as a par 4 until we have the rock on hand to finish the wall. We are all frustrated that this work is incomplete, but as someone said the other day, it is better to finish it right than quickly.

Please, for your safety, stay out of the construction area. Refrain from crossing the construction fence to retrieve a golf ball.
