2. Attach a two page (maximum) statement explaining why you believe the nominee deserves the Thomas Green Clemson Award. *Be specific in identifying and explaining the contributions of your nominee. Do not simply list activities and awards – address the importance and significance of the accomplishments to improving academic life at Clemson.*
3. Send this completed form with your one-two page attachment to the attention of the Thomas Green Clemson Award Selection Committee, Office of the Provost, 206 Sikes Hall.
