Reviews of faculty — key annual activity reporting points

The University community of students and scholars thrives because of all you do — thank you for taking the time to document your contributions to Clemson, higher education and the academy.

- Clemson uses <u>Faculty Success</u> for faculty review systems (Annual reviews, TPR and PTR).
- May 8: Reports from spring course evaluations will be available.
- Full-time faculty activity reporting of AY24-25 activities is open for the annual review workflow, which will launch on May 8.
- Annual reviews focus on activities between May 16, 2024, and May 15, 2025. If you see any inconsistencies or incorrect data in your Faculty Success Activities, please contact dmadmin@clemson.edu.

The following has been loaded for you:

- Directed student learning.
- Scheduled teaching.
- Proposals entered through InfoEd and known contracts on campus (project awards and expenditures).

In addition, some faculty service and professional development activities completed on campus auto-populate.

Annual goals for academic year 2025-26: access opens

Faculty set goals for each academic year and reflect on these goals as part of their annual review.

Some updates since last year:

- While reflecting on 2024-25, you can now enter your 2025-26 goals.
- More flexibility to the goals area: "Other" section to add items that don't fit into the traditional buckets.

 All numeric percentages and all text goals are now together. Percentages must add up to 100 percent for the term, not for the year. (So teaching, research and service - and other categories - for Fall should equal 100 percent and should equal 100 percent for Spring.)

As you wrap up the academic year, consider setting a goal for one award to pursue next year and one ambitious award to work toward over the next five years.


