**Proposed Catalog Description**

A minor in Economics requires ECON 3140 or 3060, 3150 or 3020, and nine additional credits from economics courses numbered 3000 or higher. Note that ECON 2110 and ECON 2120 are prerequisites to completion of the minor. Some 3000-level and 4000-level elective classes may have additional prerequisites.

**Summary / Explanation**

This change will broaden the appeal of the minor and expand options for students by adding an alternative for both the microeconomic theory (ECON 3060 Managerial Economics) and macroeconomic theory (ECON 3020 Money and Banking).
